Student Performance Data is used by the teacher to drive instructional programs and improve student performance.

The objective of NCC's SES Program to engage, motivate and provide children with hands-on, meaningful learning experiences that will maximize their potential and build students confidence and proficiency in literacy and mathematics. Our primary goals are to:

- ▶ Reinforce learning that occurs during the regular school day
- ▶ Provide time and space for quiet study
- ▶ Provide educational enrichment activities that spark curiosity and love of learning

The program is 120 minutes of intervention activities during after-school hours four days per week.
